Temperatures range from 5°C to 15°C (41°F to 59°F) in the north and can dip lower in the south, ideal for skiing and winter sports in the mountains.

Spring (September to November)

Temperatures range from 10°C to 20°C (50°F to 68°F), making it a great time for hiking, exploring, and enjoying the blooming landscapes.

Summer (December to February)

Summer temperatures range from 20°C to 30°C (68°F to 86°F), perfect for outdoor activities like hiking, cycling, and relaxing on the beaches.

Fall (March to May)

Fall offers mild temperatures ranging from 15°C to 25°C (59°F to 77°F), ideal for sightseeing and enjoying the autumn foliage.

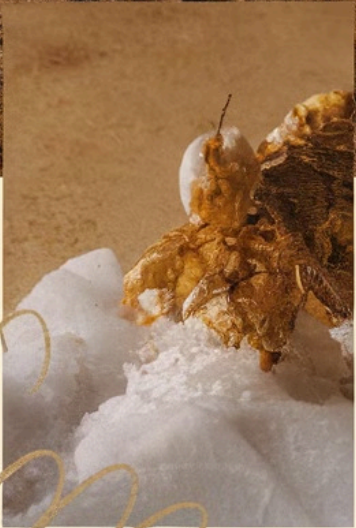
Discover Waitangi Treaty Grounds in the Bay of Islands, or learn about New Zealand's cultural heritage at the Te Papa Museum in Wellington.
